Unregistered	Flu Shingles PPV	Adults Children  For the shingles vaccination, in addition to the defined eligible cohorts, patients who are shielding and have turned or will reach the age of 80 during the lockdown period.  This SLA should not be used to vaccinate GP staff as there is a separate mechanism for this.	Individual GP practice	This SLA allows GPs to provide a flu vaccination to any patient who is not registered with a GP practices. The practice should encourage the patient to register with them.
GP Confed/PCN	Flu	Adults Children	GP Confederation PCN	If the GP does not have capacity to vaccinate all eligible patients or requires extra support, this SLA provides a mechanism by which Confeds/PCNs can vaccinate the GPs patients.
