

Care Quality Commission Registration

What does it mean for you?

Timelines

July 2012	CQC will send you a registration letter in July 2012 to start the process which includes your online registration application and a 12-digit registration access code that you'll need to start your online application*
August 2012	Review your online application. You can begin to complete your online application even though your submission window will be between September – December 2012 [^]
September - December 2012	<p>Submit your online application according to the relevant deadline of which you have been informed.</p> <p>If your submission window is towards the end of 2012 continue to review your online application as of August 2012.</p>
September 2012 – April 2013	Between the time you submit your form and April 2013, CQC will assess your application and let you know the outcome. In some cases, CQC may need to ask you for additional information or come and visit you if they have concerns.
April 2013 Onwards	CQC registration of primary medical services is complete, as you only need to register once. CQC monitoring of standards will then begin.

***If you are expecting to register with CQC and haven't received a letter with your 12 digit code, email 2012registration@cqc.org.uk with your full contact details and CQC will send it to you.**

[^]You should be aware that the December 2012 submission window is now fully booked and it is expected that the November 2012 submission window will be fully booked equally as quickly. Please ensure you open your online account and select a submission window as soon as possible, as if you delay you are likely to end up having restricted choice and may need to complete your registration a lot earlier than you may have wanted.
