



PMS Contract Reviews- Londonwide LMCs' Bulletin 5

The PMS London Offer

Londonwide LMCs has raised with NHSE London our concern that a considerable number of outstanding items remain unresolved.

Following the letter from Lockhart's Solicitors on our behalf challenging the timetable and details of the revised PMS elements, we have received a response from NHSE London as requested by 8 April. This states that an extension to the timeline is being considered centrally by the Department of Health, but as yet, we have not received any confirmation on revised dates.

Until Londonwide LMCs is reassured that all aspects of the London PMS offer have been fully completed, are completely acceptable and in a position to be finalised locally by CCGs, our advice is:

- Practices should not sign any contractual documentation in relation to the PMS London offer or any local PMS offer made by their CCG.
- Practices should seek independent professional advice as to whether acceptance or rejection of any PMS offer is suitable for their individual practice requirements.
- Practices, GPs, and LMC members either as individuals or groups, should not be engaging in any PMS discussions locally without seeking further advice and support from their borough LMC or Londonwide LMCs.

Londonwide LMCs will keep you fully updated as discussions proceed
