Age group	Payment due to the practice
0-10 year olds	Covered by the Global Sum (assuming the practice provides additional services under the contract).
10-16 year olds (i.e. catch up target cohort, born 1997 – 2003)	£1.50 per patient is payable for identifying, contacting in writing and offering an appointment for vaccination. No payment for administering the vaccine is due as this is covered by the Global Sum.
<p>Patients called in for vaccination when 15 years old but vaccinated on or after their 16th birthday</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Patients between 16 and 17 invited for vaccination but vaccinated either before or after their 17th birthday</p>	<p>For both of these cohorts:</p> <p>£1.50 per patient is payable for identifying, contacting and offering an appointment for vaccination</p> <p><u>PLUS</u></p> <p>£7.64 per dose of vaccine administered is payable</p>
16 years old & over	£7.64 per dose is payable for administering the vaccine to those patients in this cohort who request it.
Please note that as the MMR vaccine is centrally supplied, practices cannot claim for reimbursement of vaccines costs through the PPA.
